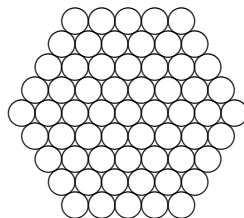


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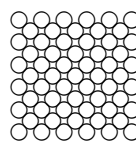


Corresponding ordinal: sixty-first.

The number 61 is the thirty-first odd number, the eighteenth prime number, and the forty-seventh deficient number.

The number 61 is a centered hexagonal number, as you can see.

The number 61 is also a centered square number.



The number 61 appears in the seventh pair of twin primes 59, 61.

As a sum of four or fewer squares: $61 = 5^2 + 6^2 = 3^2 + 4^2 + 6^2 = 2^2 + 2^2 + 2^2 + 7^2 = 2^2 + 4^2 + 4^2 + 5^2$.

As a sum of nine or fewer cubes: $61 = 7 \cdot 1^3 + 2 \cdot 3^3 = 2 \cdot 1^3 + 4 \cdot 2^3 + 3^3$.

As a difference of two squares: $61 = 31^2 - 30^2$.

The number 61 appears in two Pythagorean triples: $[11, 60, 61]$ and $[61, 1860, 1861]$. They are both primitive, of course.

As a sum of three odd primes: $61 = 3 + 5 + 53 = 3 + 11 + 47 = 3 + 17 + 41 = 3 + 29 + 29 = 5 + 13 + 43 = 5 + 19 + 37 = 7 + 7 + 47 = 7 + 11 + 43 = 7 + 13 + 41 = 7 + 17 + 37 = 7 + 23 + 31 = 11 + 13 + 37 = 11 + 19 + 31 = 13 + 17 + 31 = 13 + 19 + 29 = 19 + 19 + 23$.
